SMB CONTRACTS ISSUES 2024

Women Small Business Owners Face Unique Hardships in Current Economy

The lingering effects of inflation, interest rate hikes, and other recent economic challenges continue to reverberate throughout the small business community. However, data from Entrepreneurial and Small Business Women Australia (ESBWA) reveals that the burden falls disproportionately on female business owners.

According to the Australian Bureau of Statistics (ABS), the December quarter of 2023 saw a 5% decrease in the number of new businesses entering the market and a 5.3% exit rate. This downturn comes as experts warn of a potential surge in insolvencies in 2024, reaching levels not seen since the global financial crisis.

ESBWA, an organization that supports female entrepreneurs, emphasizes the unique obstacles women in small business face. They highlight several critical issues contributing to this trend:

- Rising Costs: Taxes (including payroll and land tax), insurance premiums, and other operational expenses steadily erode business profits, sometimes leaving owners earning less than their employees.
- Limited Funding: Women-founded businesses receive a disproportionately low percentage of venture capital funding, hindering growth and innovation.
- Aggressive Tax Collection: The ATO's focus on recouping debt adds pressure to already struggling small businesses.
- Regulatory Burdens: Increased compliance requirements related to minimum wage, sustainability reporting, and employment classifications create additional hurdles for small business owners.

These factors, combined with slowing consumer demand and lingering supply chain issues, have created a perfect storm of financial instability for many SMBs. ESBWA advocates for policy reforms to provide much-needed relief:

Simplified Tax System: Reducing the complexity of the tax code would ease the administrative burden on small businesses.

Increased Access to Capital: Programs designed to provide funding specifically for female-led businesses are essential.

Supportive Regulatory Environment: Recognizing the unique challenges faced by small businesses is crucial for creating regulations that foster growth rather than stifle it.

ESBWA asserts that supporting the success of women-owned businesses is essential for the overall economic well-being. Proactive measures to address these challenges are needed to ensure a vibrant and equitable small business sector, especially during times of economic uncertainty.

Corporate Transparency Act Reporting Now in Effect

The U.S Corporate Transparency Act (CTA) went into effect on January 1, 2024, requiring millions of small businesses to file Beneficial Ownership Information (BOI) reports with FinCEN. This new law is designed to fight money laundering and other illicit activities. Understanding its implications and complying with the reporting requirements is crucial for small businesses to avoid severe penalties.

OSHA Updates Workplace Regulations

The U.S Occupational Safety and Health Administration (OSHA) and state agencies are tightening workplace safety regulations. SMBs need to be proactive to avoid costly fines and violations. New rules include expanded OSHA inspection rights, electronic injury reporting, and state-specific heat illness and workplace violence protections. Prioritize hazard mitigation, regulatory updates, compliance review, and updated training to safeguard your business.

New Reporting Rules for Small Business Lending

To improve transparency and reduce discrimination

in small business lending, the U.S Consumer Financial Protection Bureau (CFPB) is implementing new reporting requirements for banks. Lenders will need to submit demographic and income data on small business loan applicants, similar to the U.S Home Mortgage Disclosure Act (HMDA) in the mortgage industry. Due to ongoing litigation, compliance deadlines are currently suspended, but this remains a key development to watch in 2024.

NLRB Joint Employer Rule Implementation Delayed

A federal judge has temporarily stayed the implementation of the U.S NLRB's revised joint employer rule, which was set to take effect on February 26th. The delay extends to March 11th, 2024, as the court considers a legal challenge. Businesses should use this additional time to review contracts and relationships with third-party service providers, as the new rule expands the potential scope of joint employer liability.


